Dr. Everly thanked staff members for an outstanding start to the school year!

Last year, we started free breakfast meals for all students, and during the first five days, we served 3,508 breakfast meals. This year, we have served 3,925 breakfast meals. Through Community Eligibility this school year, we are able to offer free lunch meals to every student. We served 8,282 lunch meals during the first five days of school last year, and this year, we have served 9,579. This is a substantial increase, and we have received an overwhelming amount of positive feedback from parents.

Monroe Public Schools entrepreneurship program was featured in Monroe Community Foundation's report that was sent to community members throughout Monroe.
