College Applications

Each college has a different deadline for applications.

Admission deadlines can be found on each college's website.

Ask the Student Services Center if you're eligible for fee waivers!

Parchment is a FREE online tool students can use to send transcripts to the post-secondary institutions.

*This should be done in conjunction with college applications

Make sure your student has a College Board account. This helps students with college readiness, which includes sending their SAT scores to schools. Colleges will let you know if they require you to send SAT scores through College Board. Otherwise, they are already on transcripts.
